How much does a major port cost in India?

On 19 June 2024, the Government of India approved the establishment of a Major Port at Vadhavan, Maharashtra, with an estimated cost of Rs. 76,220 crore (US\$ 9.14 billion), aiming to enhance EXIM trade capacity and accommodate mega vessels, while facilitating public-private partnerships for infrastructure development.

How much cargo did India's ports handle in a year?

Collectively, these ports managed 855 million tonnes of cargo, marking a 4.3 per cent increase from the previous year's 819 million tonnes. This surge underscores the resilience and capacity of India's maritime infrastructure to accommodate rising trade volumes.

Can India build a port network like China?

Besides, India, with its strategically positioned vast coastline, can establish a systematic network of ports, similar to China's model of port clusters, which includes the integration of islands and coastal regions into a large shipping complex, connected to the mainland by state-of-the-art infrastructure.
